

IMPORTANT – SAVE FOR THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL – Wednesday, September 4, 2019
All classroom assignments are flexible and depend on actual enrollment figures. It is possible that a few changes will be made after the first day of school if the enrollment is too high in some classrooms.

Class assignments for the 2019-20 school year will be available ONLINE starting end of August 2019. We will NOT be mailing assignments to families in August. You may access this information by going to the Skyward link which is an online tool for parents to view information about all students in their family. To log onto Skyward, go to: <http://edmonds.wednet.edu> . Look for the Skyward link on the right hand side of the page. Once on the Skyward Login Page you will need to know your Login and Password. You may then view your child’s room assignment for the 2019-20 school year. You may be prompted to first update Student/Family information. You can also set your preferences for communication.

If you have misplaced this information you may call the office at Hazelwood (425) 431-7884 before June 27th or after August 12, 2019 and we can give you your login and password information. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU SAVE THIS INFORMATION. You may view all your school age children at this site (this includes middle school and high school).

Please update all information.

We will also do “robo” calls to parents to inform you of Hazelwood, PTA, District, and community events. These “robo” calls are a very informative way for us to reach all Hazelwood families.
